Our goal for Camp is to immerse children in many exciting aspects of theater: team building, improvisation, theater games, exercises, music and dance. We feel that the processes of creativity and cooperation are as important as the final production. Our camp is centered on learning, interaction and Fun.

Drama Camp Details - Both sessions will be open to kids from Kindergarten through 9th grade. The interaction between younger and older kids provides wonderful educational moments and opportunities for growth. Camp meets daily from 9am to 2:00pm at the East Sangerville Grange. Campers should arrive promptly and are asked to bring a bag lunch. Snacks and drinks will be provided.

Camp registration is limited to 25 students per session. Advanced registration is required. If your child has any

special needs, please communicate them when submitting your registration.

Once again, Emily Ellis will photograph both sessions with a DVD, Group Photo and prints will be available for purchase at the final performance.

Performances - On Friday, August 6th, there will be a performance at 7:00pm at the Center Theatre with a matinee on Saturday the 7th at 1:00pm as part of the Dover-Foxcroft Shiretown Homecoming Festivities. Parents and immediate family are invited to come to a cake and awards ceremony on Friday and will also receive 2 complimentary tickets to the performance. In addition, campers from the first session will be asked to perform their play for the second session. Schedule to be determined.
